<u>Why you don't want to</u>

Christianity can seem dull and dreary – lots of rules and regulations about things you just aren't interested in. In the minds of many, God is like a cosmic spoilsport, looking down to see who is enjoying themselves and trying to put a stop to it.

But the reality could not be further from the truth! God loves you and wants the best for you. Everything He does and says is for your ultimate good.

<u>Why you should want to</u>

We all have a deep longing to be free and to find significance in life. But we are enslaved by our selfish desires. We enjoy fulfilling them at the time, but the lack of lasting satisfaction they bring always makes us miserable in the end.

Because God loves us, He wants to set us free from ourselves – no matter what the cost is to Him. So in Christ, He "gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people" (Titus 2:14).

Jesus' death on the cross alone sets us free. Becoming a follower of Jesus – a Christian – is freedom! It allows us to become the people we were truly meant to be.

<u>Why you need to</u>

Our sinful actions don't just ruin our lives now, they will separate us from God eternally. If we are not prepared to admit that we need Jesus to save us, we face banishment from God's presence forever: "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him" (John 3:36).

Do you want to have a life that is truly meaningful? Do you want to find your purpose and fulfil it? Only in Jesus, by trusting and following Him, can you experience true freedom and true joy.












EXODUS CH. wenty: THE BIBLE

TIMELESS UNIVERSAL

REFLECTING THE UNRIVALLED GOODNESS AND GLORY OF THEIR AUTHOR; GOD.

The commandments define a good life, but are not a way to earn God's favour. Instead, they point us to Jesus Christ for forgiveness. Only then is a new kind of life possible in God's strength.



"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal...".

So begins possibly the most famous sentence written, as the newly formed United States of America set out its Declaration of Independence. This fundamental principle of human equality became the foundation of the infant nation, which today holds itself up as the bastion of human rights.

Yet this concept was not created by the founding fathers. It is one of the fundamental truths of the Bible, established in its very first chapter.

EQUALLY VALUABLE

The Bible gives us the account of the beginning of the human race. It describes how God made man distinctly different to the rest of creation:

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. Genesis 1:27

God did something He had not before. done He created someone that reflected that was made in His likeness. An astounding thought! From that point on, every person who has ever lived has borne the same the image of God. It is why every human life is of immeasurable intrinsic value and why every person should be treated with dignity and respect.

EQUALLY GUILTY

It might be difficult to believe that today. After all none of the goodness, mercy, love iustice of God seem to characterise the human race, let alone indicate we are all made in God's image. Yet that problem lies at our door, not God's. The Bible describes how God also made us with a Will to choose: and each one of us has chosen to go our own way and not God's. It describes this rebellion as sin, and makes it clear there are no exceptions:

"None is righteous, no, not one; no one understands; no one seeks for God. Romans 3:11-12

It reads as a chilling indictment of the human race. Not a generalisation but true of every individual, calling us to look at our own hearts to see the truth of what the Bible says. That just as we are all equally valuable before God, we are also all equally guilty.

EQUALLY LOVED

At the very top of the Old Bailey in London stands Lady Justice, looking out over the city blindfolded, carrying a sword in one hand and a set of scales in the other. It is a reminder that justice does not allow for favouritism or partiality, it treats all people equally.

God knows our guilt and He knows the eternal consequences we rightly face because of it. After all, He will be the Judge before whom everyone will stand one day.

Yet He is also the God who loves. Not because we deserve it, but despite the fact we don't. The most well known verse in the Bible tells us how God demonstrated that love:

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16

The message of the Bible is the message of equality. It tells us that we are all equally guilty and yet all equally loved. To the extent that God sent His own Son, Jesus Christ, to die in our place on the cross.

So that if anyone, from any race, any gender, any class, any background, turns in faith to Him, their sins will be forgiven and they will have eternal life.
